The Al Zahraa General Hospital, a 400-bed medical facility, is undergoing a comprehensive rehabilitation of its HVAC and steam systems. Energy International Corporation's role centers on upgrading key mechanical systems to ensure optimal performance, energy efficiency, and reliability in a healthcare setting where uninterrupted service is essential.

4. **Testing & Commissioning**
Overseeing start-up procedures to verify system reliability and performance.

Providing basic operational training to hospital personnel to ensure a smooth transition and long-term maintenance success.

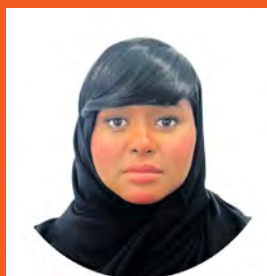

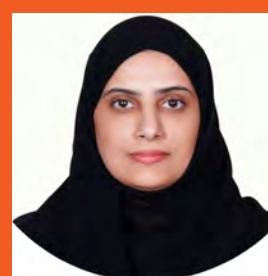
