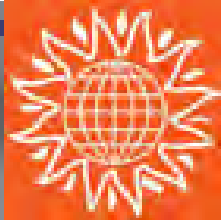

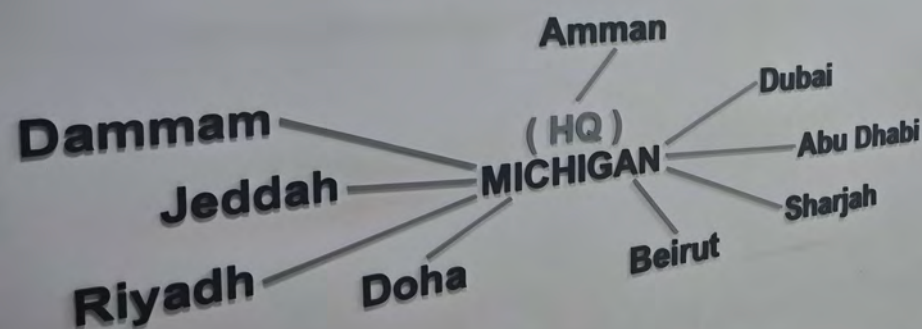

Now, 7 years later, this line of business grew from less than 50k USD per year to a fully operating, steady, and healthy business.

The Jordan office, in its ongoing effort to expand and explore additional opportunities outside the country, entered the Iraqi market in 2024 by opening a branch for Energy International in the heart of Baghdad. Additionally, the Jordan office oversaw staff hiring and training and the opening of the physical office, which has since become a highly productive arm of EIC. # EIC Qatar Secures Major Health Sector Installation

*Our Qatar Office performed a fan installation for the upcoming Sultan Qaboos Hospital*

**E**nergy International Qatar has successfully supplied laboratory high-plume exhaust fans for the New Sultan Qaboos Hospital in Salalah, Oman, one of the country's largest healthcare projects.

Spread across more than 100,000 square meters and built at an investment of approximately USD 335 million, this state-of-the-art hospital is designed to accommodate 700 beds and more than 3,200 rooms. The seven-story facility will be equipped with the latest medical technologies and specialized healthcare services, strengthening healthcare provisions in the Dhofar region.

The hospital's extensive medical facilities include accident and emergency services, medical imaging, rehabilitation, chemotherapy, dialysis, burns treatment, orthodontics, day clinics, and a range of specialized care units. Dedicated wards and intensive care facilities have been designed to support adults, children, stroke patients, and neonatal care, alongside modern operating theatres, delivery suites, private and VIP wards, and a nuclear medicine department.

For this prestigious project, Energy International Qatar worked closely with the design and engineering teams to select and supply Model BAIFE high-plume exhaust fans manufactured by Twin City Fans USA. The fans were configured in a duty-and-standby twin arrangement with a common plenum box and rear inlet duct connections, ensuring reliability and operational continuity.

Among the units supplied is the Model BAIFE 402LV, one of the largest induced-flow high-plume fume exhaust fans installed in the region. These centrifugal induced-flow high-plume fans are designed for laboratory applications, where they safely remove contaminated air containing chemicals, bacteria, viruses, and other hazardous substances. The system mixes exhaust air with fresh ambient air and discharges it high into the atmosphere, helping to prevent harmful fumes from re-entering the building.

EIC Qatar was involved throughout the project, supporting the contractor with equipment selection, delivery, and installation requirements. The company's experienced engineering team provided technical expertise at every stage, ensuring the right solution was selected and successfully implemented.

The project highlights Energy International Qatar's commitment to delivering reliable and high-quality engineering solutions across the region. ■

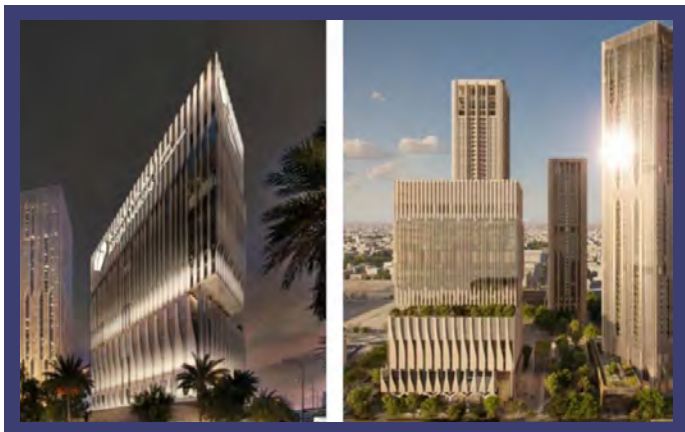
